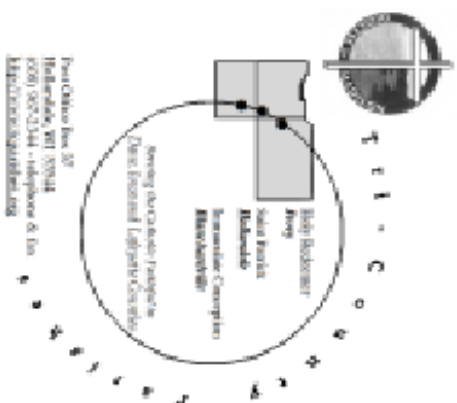

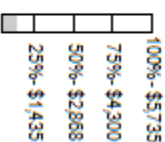
FOR PARISHIONERS OF IMMACULATE CONCEPTION ...
